4. Admission requirements:

1 - Applicants for admission to the PhD degree in Contemporary Studies must be:

a) Holders of a master's degree, or legal equivalent;

b) Holders of a bachelor's degree, holders of a particularly relevant academic or scientific curriculum that is recognized as attesting the capacity to complete this cycle of studies by the Academic Board of the Institute for Interdisciplinary Research;

c) Holders of a school, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting capacity to complete this cycle of studies by the Academic Board of the Institute for Interdisciplinary Research of the University of Coimbra;

2 - The recognition referred to in subparagraphs b) and c) of paragraph 1 only allows access to the cycle of studies leading to a PhD Degree and does not grant its holder the recognition or equivalence to a Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

5. Selection criteria:

a) Classifications obtained in the degrees presented (Weighting 3/10):

a1) Final average of Bachelor's Degree (40%);

a2) Final average of Master's Degree (60%).

b) Relevant specific qualifications for the scientific scope of the course (Weighting 1/10):

b1) Bachelor's and/or Master's degree in Human and Social Sciences - 18 points;

b2) Degree and/or Masters in other scientific areas - 16 points.

c) Scientific curriculum (Weighting 2/10):

c1) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor), no papers or articles submitted for evaluation and no participation in research projects - 10 points;

c2) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor) with participation in projects and / or other activities of scientific merit - 14 points;

c3) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor) with between 1 and 3 written communications or articles with evaluation - 16 points;

c4) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor) with more than 3 written communications or articles with evaluation - 18 points.

d) Professional curriculum (Weighting 2/10):

d1) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor), no professional experience - 10 points;

d2) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor), with between 1 and 3 years of professional experience - 12 points;

d3) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor), with proven production of projects and / or related initiatives - 14 points;

d4) Holders of academic degrees (master or pre-Bologna bachelor), with proven production of projects and / or related initiatives of international scope - 18 points.

e) Interview (Weighting 2/10).

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- 1 – Motivation letter, explaining the reasons that lead the applicant to apply, if relevant according to the criteria established by the organic unit of the desired course (MANDATORY);
- 2 - Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process - after 2007/2008);
- 3 - 1st Letter of Recommendation;
- 4 - 2nd Letter of Recommendation;
- 5 - Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma). If credits are to be requested, a certificate indicating all curricular units completed and classification obtained on each of the curricular units is required (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 6 - Certificate of Master's degree with final classification (diploma). If credits are to be requested, a certificate indicating all curricular units completed and classification obtained on each of the curricular units is required (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 7 - Curriculum Vitae (Europass format); (MANDATORY);
- 8 - Official document, issued by the institution awarding the degree, with certified grade (weighted average), (MANDATORY only for foreign candidates);
- 9 - Copy of Identification Document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants).

NOTE: Admitted candidates who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file.

The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by European Union Member-States. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant.

If the above-mentioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation must be presented. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.
