1. Number of places:

1st call: 7 places 2nd call: 7 places

3rd call: 1 + remaining places

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 5

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 4th February to 29th March 2019 2nd call: 1st April to 15th July 2019

3rd call: 19th August to 6th September 2019

4. Admission requirements:

- 1- Applicants for admission to the Doctoral Programme in Economics must be:
- a) Holders of a master's degree or legal equivalent, namely holders of a Master's degree in Economics with a Very Good classification or equivalent rank or holders of a master's degree in other fields, with a Very Good classification or equivalent rank, or holders of a bachelor's degree with Very Good classification or equivalent rank in the school part of master's in Economics or related fields:
- b) Holders of a bachelor's degree in the fields referred to in sub-paragraph a), holders of a particularly relevant academic or scientific curriculum that is recognized as attesting capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the Academic Board of the Faculty of Economics;

- c) Holders of a scholarly, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting to the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the Academic Board of the Faculty of Sciences and Technology of the University of Coimbra.
- 2 The recognition referred to in subparagraphs b) and c) of paragraph 1 only allows access to the cycle of studies leading to a PhD Degree and does not grant its holder the recognition or equivalence to a Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

5. Selection criteria:

- 1.1 Academic Curriculum: Undergraduate Degree (Weighting 3/10): Applicants with bachelor's or master's degrees with insufficient content in the areas of mathematics and statistics will be penalized;
- 1.2 Academic curriculum: Other academic courses (Weighting 2/10): Applicants with bachelor's or master's degrees with insufficient content in the areas of mathematics and statistics will be penalized;
- 1.3 Academic curriculum: Publications/Research (Weighting 2/10): Applicants with professional experience that may be useful for success in the doctoral program will be valued;
- 2. Professional Curriculum: Professional Merit Assessment (Weighting 1/10): Applicants with publications that reveal some maturity in the field of research will be valued;
- 3. Motivation (includes, if necessary, an interview): Applicant's Profile (Weighting 2/10): The candidate's chances of success in the program will be assessed, taking particularly into account the quality of backgound education, argumentation skills and the knowledge of economic concepts, revealed in the motivation letter and in the text justifying the interest in the doctoral program.

 NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- 1 Motivation letter, explaining the reasons that lead the applicant to apply, if relevant according to the criteria established by the organic unit of the desired course (MANDATORY);
- 2 Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process after 2007/2008);

- 3 1st Letter of Recommendation (MANDATORY);
- 4 2nd Letter of Recommendation (MANDATORY);
- 5 Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma). If credits are to be requested, a certificate indicating all curricular units completed and classification obtained on each of the curricular units is required (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 6 Certificate of Master's degree with final classification (diploma). If credits are to be requested, a certificate indicating all curricular units completed and classification obtained on each of the curricular units is required (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 7 Certificates of other post-graduate courses, if any, including workloads and programmes;
- 8 Curriculum Vitae (Europass format); (MANDATORY);
- 9 Official document, issued by the institution awarding the degree, with certified grade (weighted average), (MANDATORY only for foreign candidates);
- 10 Copy of Identification Document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants).
- 11 Statement of Interest on PhD program / Research project proposal (1000 words) (MANDATORY);

NOTE: Admitted candidates who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file.

The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by European Union Member-States. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant. If the above-mentioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation must be presented. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.
