1st call: 1 place

NOTE: Places only for the field of specialization in Educational Psychology, Development and Counseling.

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable.

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 4th February to 29th March 2019

2nd call: 1st April to 15th July 2019

3rd call: 19th August to 6th September 2019

4. Admission requirements:

- Pre-Bologna graduates in Psychology.

Pursuant to the Rectoral Order no. 137 / 2011.

5. Selection criteria:

- CV assessment (preference is given to candidates with academic and scientific curriculum relevant to the area of specialization of application) (Weighting 4/10);

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ADMINISTRATION

- Relevant professional activity for the area of specialization of application (Weighting 3/10);
- Classification of Bachelor's degree (Weighting 3/10).

6. Required documentation:

1. Motivation letter, explaining the reasons that lead the applicant to apply, in case that is relevant to the criteria established by the Faculty they are applying to (MANDATORY);
2. Course outlines and hourly course loads of previous courses, in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by a foreign institution according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a State compliant with this process / awarded by the University of Coimbra);
3. Transcript detailing subjects studied (ECTS or hours) and grade per subject is required (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
4. Diploma (bachelor's degree or equivalent) with overall grade (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
5. Curriculum vitae, EuroPass format (<http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>) (MANDATORY);
6. Copy of identification document (MANDATORY for international applicants only).
7. - A summary of relevant professional experience for the area you are applying for Masters, where it should be appointed the date, time and location (the employer's exercise of the function and description of main activities and responsibilities. This summary must not exceed two pages (MANDATORY);
8. Indication of the area of specialization in which the applicant seeks a master's degree, the same being confirmed or redefined by the Commission of Accreditation from the curricular analysis. This decision cannot be appealed (MANDATORY);

NOTE: Admitted applicants who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file.

The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by countries of the European

Union. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant.

If the abovementioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation is required. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.

- Portuguese students or equivalent: 871,52 EUR (annual fee);
- International student: 7,000 EUR (annual fee).

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a fee in the amount of 50.00 €, non-refundable, including in cases of invalidation of application, non-placement or when the study cycle does not open due to the lack of the minimum number of enrollees.
- Registration and enrollment of International Students is only confirmed after a single payment corresponding to 30% of the total tuition fee (payment of 3 months of tuition), plus the application fee.
