1. Number of places:

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 8

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 4th February to 15th July 2019

4. Admission requirements:

Students may be readmitted to this course if they:

- a) Have already been enrolled and registered in that same course at the University of Coimbra;
- b) Have not been registered in that course in the previous school year to which they intend to be readmitted in, even if they have dropped out in that school year.

NOTE: In terms of the Assessment for this course, admission to the 2nd year of the course depends on obtaining an average of 14 values in the curricular units of the 1st year.

5. Selection criteria:

- Not applicable.

6. Required documentation:

- Letter of motivation, explaining the reasons that lead the applicant to apply, if relevant according to the criteria established by the Faculty of the desired course (MANDATORY);
- Copy of identification document (MANDATORY only for international candidates).

- Registration and enrollment of International Students is only confirmed after a single payment corresponding to 30% of the total tuition fee (payment of 3 months of tuition), plus the application fee.
