Integrated Master's Degree in Psychology

1. Number of places:

1st call: 13 places

Places for access to the 4th year of the Integrated Master's Degree in Psychology:

- Clinical Psychogerontology - 1 place;
- Psychopathology and Dynamic Psychotherapies - 2 places;
- Systemic Psychotherapy and Family - 1 place;
- Educational Psychology, Development and Counseling - 1 place;
- Occupational and Organizations Psychology - 1 place.

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable.

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 3rd June to 16th August 2019

4. Admission requirements:

This regime accepts applicants that:

1. Hold a former bachelor's (3 years), bachelor's, master's or doctor's degree;
2. Hold the extinct courses of the Primary Magisterium, of Childhood Educators and of General Nursing and also a secondary education course, a complementary course to the secondary education or the 10th / 11th grade of secondary school;
3. Are not covered by the international student's statute regulated by Decree-Law no. 36/2014, of

March 10, amended and republished by Decree-Law no. 62/2018, of August 6.

Note: Applicants of Portuguese nationality, with a higher education academic degree obtained abroad can apply as long as they hold degree equivalence or recognition of qualifications.

5. Selection criteria:

1. Degree level in descending order (PhD, Master's, Bachelor's degree, Former Bachelor's course - pre-Bologna process) (3/6 Weighting);
2. Course classification in descending order, (1/6 Weighting);
3. Preference is given to applicants who have completed their qualifications most recently (1/6 Weighting);
4. Place (criterion related to the existence of places in the specialization area for applicants who attend the 4th year of the course), (1/6 Weighting)

NOTE: The assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

1. Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process - after 2007/2008);
2. Motivation letter (MANDATORY);
3. Transcript detailing subjects studied (ECTS or hours) and grade per subject is required (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
4. Diploma (higher education course) with overall grade (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
5. Curriculum vitae, EuroPass format (<http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>) (MANDATORY);
6. Copy of identification document;
7. Indication of the specialization area in which the applicant intends to obtain the degree of Master, which will be confirmed or redefined by the Credit Commission based on CV analysis. This decision shall not be subject to appeal. (MANDATORY, only for candidates with a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology)

NOTE: Admitted applicants who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file.

The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or

legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by countries of the European Union. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant.

If the abovementioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation is required. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.

7. Tuition fee:

- Portuguese students or equivalent: 871.52 EUR (annual fee);

8. Part-time registration: Allowed.

9. Assessment committee:

- Marcelino Arménio Martins Pereira.

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a fee in the amount of 50.00 €, non-refundable, including in cases of invalidation of application, non-placement or when the study cycle does not open due to the lack of the minimum number of enrollees.
