Postgraduate studies in Economics and Management in Health Organizations

1. Number of places:

1st call: 0 places 2nd call: 5 places

3rd call: 12 + remaining places

Note: 2 places out of the total places are destined to recent graduates by FEUC (bachelor's degree

obtained in the last two academic years).

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 8

3. Application deadlines:

2nd call: 1st April to 15th July 2019

3rd call: 19th August to 6th September 2019

4. Admission requirements:

Applicants for admission to the Postgraduate studies in Economics and Management in Health Organizations must be:

- a) Holders of a Bachelor's degree, or legal equivalent, namely holders of degrees taught at FEUC or equivalent, as well as holders of degrees in Medicine, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Nursing, Health Technologies or other appropriate degrees;
- b) Holders of a foreign higher academic degree awarded following a 1st cycle of studies organized according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a State compliant with this Process;
- c) Holders of foreign higher education degree that is recognized as meeting the objectives of a

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bachelor's degree by the Scientific Committee of the Faculty of Economics;

d) In duly justified cases, holders of a scientific and professional curriculum relevant for completing this cycle of studies as recognized the competent Scientific Committee.

5. Selection criteria:

- 1. Academic, professional and research curriculum (includes, if necessary, an interview) (Weighting 10/10):
- 1.1 Academic curriculum (60%)

Academic evolution of the candidates (2nd and 3rd cycles) and scientific area in which they obtained the degrees.

- 1.2. Professional and research curriculum (40%)

Existence of publications or participation in research projects and management and / or management functions that they may perform in their professional activity. The situation of recent graduates is taken into account.

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- 1 Motivation letter, explaining the reasons that lead the applicant to apply, if relevant according to the criteria established by the organic unit of the desired course (MANDATORY);
- 2 Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process after 2007/2008);
- 3 Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma). If credits are to be requested, a certificate indicating all curricular units completed and classification obtained on each of the curricular units is required (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 4 Certificate of other post-graduate courses completed, if any, including workload and programmes;
- 5 Curriculum Vitae, available at http://www.uc.pt/feuc/eea/mestrados/Documentos/CV_Saude (MANDATORY);
- 6 Document mentioning the specific curricular units for which equivalence is requested and the previous 2nd cycle course (or pre-Bologna bachelor's degree) completed, which may justify such equivalence (REQUIRED if you wish to request credit equivalence);
- 7 Copy of Identification Document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants).

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NOTE: Admitted candidates who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file.

The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by European Union Member-States. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant. If the above-mentioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation must be presented. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.
