Master in Teaching of Physical Education in Basic and Secondary School

1. Number of places:

1st call: 20 places 2nd call: 55 places

3rd call: 5 places + remaining places*

*NOTE: Applications that give access to the 2nd year of the Study Plan are not accepted, since the

Pedagogical Internship will begin in September in the Network of Cooperating Schools.

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable.

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 4th February to 29th March 2019 2nd call: 1st April to 15th July 2019

3rd call: 19th August to 6th September 2019

4. Admission requirements:

- 1. In accordance with Decree Law 79/2014, applicants to this Master's course must meet all of the following conditions:
- a) Hold a bachelor's degree or one of the qualifications referred to in points a) to c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of Decree Law no. 115/2013, of August 7;
- b) Have obtained 120 credits (ECTS) in the scientific area of Sport or Physical Education in that degree or in other higher education study cycles, or to hold a 1st cycle course with a minimum

number of 90 ECTS in these areas, in which case the candidate will have to complete 30 ECTS during the master's course.

- c) Have oral and written command of the Portuguese language and mastery of the essential rules of logical and critical argumentation.
- 2. Fulfil the requirements of paragraphs a) and c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of Decree Law no. 65/2018, of August 7, but not of letter b), and have obtained in the teaching areas 75% of the credits required.
- 3 Fulfil the requirements of paragraphs b) and c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of Decree-Law no. 65/2018, of August 7, but not of sub-paragraph a), and hold a school, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the Scientific Council of the Faculty of Sports Sciences and Physical Education of the University of Coimbra.
- 4 Obtain approval in a written and oral exam aimed at verifying the level of the Portuguese language and the capacity for logical and critical argumentation.

NOTE: It is not possible to access the 2nd year of the Study Plan, if all curricular units of the 1st year are not successfully completed.

Access to Teaching Masters requires a Portuguese test, see the test dates at https://www.uc.pt/candidatos/escola/fcdefuc/prova_portugues.

5. Selection criteria:

- 1. Academic degree (Sports or Physical Education) and institution of origin (2/6 Weighting);
- 2. Classification of Bachelor's Degree (3/6 Weighting);
- 3. Professional curriculum (1/6 Weighting).

6. Required documentation:

- Motivation letter, explaining the reasons that lead the applicant to apply, if relevant according to the criteria established by the organic unit of the desired course (MANDATORY);
- Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process after 2007/2008);
- Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma). If credits are to be requested, a certificate indicating all curricular units completed and classification obtained on each of the curricular units is required (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- Curriculum Vitae (Europass format) (MANDATORY);

- Official document, issued by the institution awarding the degree, with certified grade (weighted average), (MANDATORY only for foreign candidates);
- Curricular structure with indication of the distribution of ECTS by the Scientific areas of the course held. Mandatory document, unless the course was obtained at FCDEFUC;
- Copy of Identification Document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants).

NOTE: Admitted candidates who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file.

The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by European Union Member-States. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant. If the above-mentioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation must be presented. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.

7. Tuition fee:

- National Student or equivalent: 1,063,4 EUR (Fee amount subject to amendment by the General Council);
- International student: 7,000 EUR (annual fee).
- **8. Part-time registration:** Allowed.

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a fee in the amount of $50.00 \in$, non-refundable, including in cases of invalidation of application, non-placement or when the study cycle does not open due to the lack of the minimum number of enrollees.
- Registration and enrollment of International Students is only confirmed after a single payment corresponding to 30% of the total tuition fee (payment of 3 months of tuition), plus the application fee.
