3rd cycle Doctoral Programme in Sociology

1. Number of places:

1st call: 12 places

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 5

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 10th February to 15th July 2020

4. Admission requirements:

- 1- Applicants for access to the Doctoral Programme in Sociology:
- a) Holders of a master's degree or legal equivalent;
- b) Holders of a bachelor's degree, holders of a particularly relevant academic or scientific curriculum that is recognized as attesting capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the Academic Board of the Faculty of Economics;
- c) Holders of a school, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting to the ability to carry out this cycle of studies by the Academic Board of the Faculty of Economics.
- 2 The recognition referred to in subparagraphs b) and c) of paragraph 1 only allows access to the cycle of studies leading to a PhD Degree and does not grant its holder the recognition or equivalence to a Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

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5. Selection criteria:

- 1.1 Academic curriculum: Undergraduate degree, (3/10 Weighting);
- 1.2 Academic curriculum: Other academic training, (3/10 Weighting);
- 1.3 Academic curriculum: Publications/Research, (1/10 Weighting);
- 2. Professional curriculum: Professional Merit assessment, (1/10 Weighting);
- 3. Motivation (includes, if necessary, an interview): Applicant's profile, (2/10 Weighting).

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- 1 1st Letter of Recommendation; (MANDATORY, except when the last academic degree has been obtained at FEUC);
- 2 2nd Letter of Recommendation; (MANDATORY, except when the last academic degree has been obtained at FEUC);
- 3 Certificate from Master's degree with final course classification obtained (Master degree diploma); (MANDATORY, except if the origin course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 4 Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma); (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);
- 5 Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- 6 Diploma(s) of proficiency in foreign languages (if available);
- 7 Identity Document; (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- 8 Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- 9 Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request; (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process after 2007/2008);
- 10 Official document, issued by the institution conferring the degree, with certified grade (weighted average); (MANDATORY, only for foreign candidates);
- 11 Statement of Interest on PhD program / Research project draft proposal (1000 words); (MANDATORY).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted

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who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.

- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply **conditionally**. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become "Not Admitted" in the final ranking list.
