## **3rd cycle PhD in Civil Engineering**

### 1. Number of places:

1st call: 10 places 2nd call: 19 places 3rd call: 1 + remaining places Extra call: remaining places

### 2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable.

#### **3.** Application deadlines:

1st call: 10th February to 31st March 2020 2nd call: 1st April to 15th July 2020 3rd call: 17th August to 30th September 2020 Extra call: 02nd to 06th November2020

### 4. Admission requirements:

1 - Applicants for admission to the PhD in Civil Engineering must be:

a) Holders of the master's degree in Civil Engineering or any other appropriate, namely Environmental Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Naval Engineering and Architecture, or legal equivalent;

b) Holders of a bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering or any other appropriate, such as Environmental Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Naval Engineering and Architecture, with at

least 5 years of academic training in Higher Education, full time or equivalent degree obtained abroad;

c) In duly justified cases, holders of a school, scientific or professional curriculum relevant for pursuing this cycle of studies as recognized by the Scientific Committee of FCTUC. Applicants must obtain a curricular evaluation equal to or higher than 12 points.

2 - The recognition referred to in subparagraphs b) and c) of paragraph 1 only allows access to the cycle of studies leading to a PhD Degree and does not grant its holder the recognition or equivalence to a Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

#### 5. Selection criteria:

The score is on a sclae of 0 to 20 and results from the application of the following formula: C = PA x 2/3 + EM x 1/3, being:

EM- Commitment, motivation and letters of recommendation (an interview or complementary information may be requested to clarify any doubts).

PA- Quality of the academic course, complementary training and/or professional experience:

 $PA = MC \ge 1/4 + FB \ge 2/4 + FC \ge 1/4$ 

MC - Grade average of degree;

FB - Prior training;

FC - Complementary training and/or professional experience.

Regarding the access referred to in sub-paragraph c) of paragraph 1 of the conditions of admission the application evaluator assesses the CV of applicants and rates it on a scale of 0 to 20 following the criteria i) to iv) and their respective weights:

i) School curriculum, considering the final classification of the course (s) taken by the applicant (25%);

ii) Relevance of the course (s) taken to the scientific area of the study cycle to which you they are applying (25%);

iii) Scientific Curriculum, considering the participation of applicants in congresses, seminars, research projects, number and scientific quality of publications (monographs, book chapters, articles in periodicals), prizes and similar elements, as long as these activities are developed in the scientific area of the study cycle in question (25%);

iv) Professional curriculum, considering the duration and nature of the professional activity in the scientific area of the study cycle in question (25%).



NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

#### 6. Required documentation:

1 - 1st Letter of Recommendation;

2 - 2nd Letter of Recommendation;

3 - Certificate from Master's degree with final course classification obtained (Master degree diploma) (MANDATORY, except if the origin course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);

4 - Certificate of degree with final classification obtained (diploma) (MANDATORY, except if the origin course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);

5 - Copy of Identity Document (Mandatory for international applicants);

6 - Curriculum vitae; (MANDATORY);

7 - Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);

8 - Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008);

9 - Official document, issued by the institution conferring the degree, with certified grade (weighted average), (MANDATORY only for foreign candidates).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.
