2nd cycle Geographic Information Technologies - GIT

1. Number of places:

1st call: 15 places 2nd call: 13 places

3rd call: 2 places + remaining places

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 6

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 10th February to 31st March 2020

2nd call: 1st April to 15th July 2020

3rd call: 17th August to 15th september 2020

4. Admission requirements:

- 1. Applicants to this 2nd cycle course must:
- a) Hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent;
- b) Hold a higher education degree awarded by a foreign institution after a 1st study cycle structured according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a participating country;
- c) Hold a foreign academic degree that is recognized by the GIT Scientific Council, as meeting the objectives of a graduation course;
- d) Holders of an academic, scientific or professional CV recognized as adequate for pursuing this cycle of studies by the Scientific Committee of the Faculty of Arts of the University of Coimbra, in which applicants must obtain an evaluation of 9.5 points or higher.
- 2. The recognition referred to in sub-paragraphs b) to d) of paragraph 1 only provides access to the

study cycle leading to the degree of master and does not confer the equivalence to the degree of bachelor or the recognition of that degree.

NOTE: Applicants are recommended to have minimum knowledge in Geographic Information Science and Technologies.

5. Selection criteria:

- a) Classification of Bahelor's degree or equivalent, (6/10 Weighting);
- b) Curriculum vitae, (3/10 Weighting);
- c) Motivation candidate, (1/10 Weighting).

Regarding the access referred to in sub-paragraph d) of paragraph 1 of the conditions of admission: The CV of applicants is rated on a scale of 0 to 20 in criteria i) to iv) and according to their respective weights:

- i) Academic curriculum, considering the final classification of the degree(s) held (25%);
- ii) Relevance of the degree(s) held for the scientific area of the study cycle (25%);
- iii) Scientific curriculum, considering participation in congresses, seminars, research projects, number and scientific quality of publications (monographs, book chapters, articles in periodicals), prizes and similar awards, provided these activities are in the scientific area of the study cycle in question (25%);
- iv) Professional curriculum, considering the duration and nature of the professional activities performed in the scientific area of the study cycle in question (25%).

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- Certificate of Bachelor Degree with final grade average (diploma) (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra);
- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Identification document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process after 2007/2008);
- Official document, issued by the Institution awarding the degree, indicating the weighted average

(MANDATORY only for foreign applicants that present a diploma that does not specify weighted average).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.

7. Tuition fee:

- Portuguese students or equivalent: 1,250 EUR (annual fee);
- International student: 7,000 EUR (annual fee).
- **8. Part-time registration:** Allowed.

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a 50EUR fee, which is non-refundable, even in case of invalidation of application and of non-placement or when the study cycle does not open due to the lack of the minimum number of enrollees.
- Applications are submitted online at: https://inforestudante.uc.pt/nonio/security/candidaturas.do;
- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply **conditionally**. If they do not submit the required documents until the new deadline provided, they can move their application into the following call without any additional charges. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become "Not Admitted" in the final ranking list.
- After the last phase of applications, and if there are still places available, applicants may submit their application by means of a request which will be duly appraised by the coordination of the Course /Organisational Unit.
