### **1. Number of places:**

1st call: 12 places#

# 6 places for access to the 4th year of the Integrated Master's Degree in Psychology:

- Psychopathology and Dynamic Psychotherapies - 2 places;
- Systemic Psychotherapy and Family - 1 place;
- Educational Psychology, Development and Counseling - 1 place;
- Occupational and Organizations Psychology - 1 place.

**NOTE:** The approval of the number of places depends on the guiding order regarding the establishment of places, for the academic year 2020/2021, which will be published by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Higher Education (MCTES) and which may, consequently, imply changes.

**2. Minimum number of students for course opening:** Not applicable.

### **3. Application deadlines:**

1st call: 1st June to 14th August 2020

### **4. Admission requirements:**

1. Hold a bachelor's, master's or doctor's degree;
2. Hold the extinct courses of the Primary Magisterium, of Childhood Educators and of General Nursing and also a secondary education course, a complementary course to the secondary education

or the 10th / 11th grade of secondary school;

3. Are not covered by the international student's statute regulated by Decree-Law no. 36/2014, of March 10, amended and republished by Decree-Law no. 62/2018, of August 6.

**NOTE:** Applicants of Portuguese nationality or equivalent, with a higher academic degree obtained abroad, can apply as long as they hold a degree equivalence or recognition of qualifications.

**5. Selection criteria:**

1. Degree level in descending order (PhD, Master's, Bachelor's degree, Former Bachelor's course - pre-Bologna process), (3/6 Weighting);
2. Course classification in descending order, (1/6 Weighting);
3. Preference is given to applicants who have completed their qualifications most recently, (1/6 Weighting)
4. Place (criterion related to the existence of places in the specialization area for applicants who attend the 4th year of the course), (1/6 Weighting).

**NOTE:** The assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

**6. Required documentation:**

- Certificate from higher education course completed with average classification obtained; (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
- Curriculum vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Identification document;
- Indication of the specialization area in which the applicant intends to obtain the degree of Master, which will be confirmed or redefined by the Credit Commission based on CV analysis. This decision shall not be subject to appeal. (MANDATORY, only for candidates with a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Transcript detailing subjects studied (ECTS or hours) and grade per subject (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
- Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008).

**NOTE:** If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a

translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.

**7. Tuition fee:**

- Portuguese students or equivalent: 871,52 EUR (fee subject to change after approval of the 2020 state budget).

**8. Part-time registration:** Allowed.

**10. Other information:**

- Application is subject to the payment of a 50EUR fee, which is non-refundable, even in case of invalidation of application and of non-placement or when the study cycle does not open due to the lack of the minimum number of enrollees.

- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply **conditionally**. If they do not submit the required documents until the new deadline provided, they can move their application into the following call without any additional charges. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become “Not Admitted” in the final ranking list.
