2nd cycle

Master in Teaching of Physical Education in Basic and Secondary School

1. Number of places:

1st call: 20 places

2nd call: 55 places

3rd call: 5 places + remaining places*

***NOTE:** Applications that give access to the 2nd year of the Study Plan are not accepted, since the Pedagogical Internship will begin in September in the Network of Cooperating Schools.

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable.

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 1st to 30th April 2021

2nd call: 1st June to 16th July 2021

3rd call: 1st to 10th September 2021

4. Admission requirements:

1. In accordance with Decree Law 79/2014, applicants to this Master's course must meet all of the following conditions:

a) Hold a bachelor's degree or one of the qualifications referred to in points a) to c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of Decree Law no. 115/2013, of August 7;

b) Have obtained 120 credits (ECTS) in the scientific area of Sport or Physical Education in that degree or in other higher education study cycles, or to hold a 1st cycle course with a minimum

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number of 90 ECTS in these areas, in which case the candidate will have to complete 30 ECTS during the master's course.

c) Have oral and written command of the Portuguese language and mastery of the essential rules of logical and critical argumentation.

2. Fulfil the requirements of paragraphs a) and c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of Decree Law no. 65/2018, of August 7, but not of letter b), and have obtained in the teaching areas 75% of the credits required.

3 - Fulfil the requirements of paragraphs b) and c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of Decree-Law no. 65/2018, of August 7, but not of sub-paragraph a), and hold a school, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the Scientific Council of the Faculty of Sports Sciences and Physical Education of the University of Coimbra.

4 - Obtain approval in a written and oral exam aimed at verifying the level of the Portuguese language and the capacity for logical and critical argumentation.

NOTES:

- It is not possible to access the 2nd year of the Study Plan, if all curricular units of the 1st year are not successfully completed.

- Access to Teaching Masters requires a Portuguese test.

Date of the Portuguese tests:

1st application phase: May 10, at 11 a.m. (written test) and May 12 at 9.30 a.m. (oral test)

2nd phase of applications: July 23, 11 a.m. (writing test) and July 27, 9.30 a.m. (speaking test/ interview)

3rd phase of applications: September 17, 11 a.m. (writing test) and September 21, 9.30 a.m (speaking test / interview)

5. Selection criteria:

1. Academic degree (Sports or Physical Education) and Institution of origin, (Weighting 2/6);

1.1. Undergraduate courses with Physical Education component from Higher Education Schools: 10 points

1.2. Other bachelor's degrees in Sports (with various designations) in Polytechnic Education: 12 points

1.3. Bachelor's Degree in Sports and Physical Education in University Education: 14 points

2. Final classification of the Bachelor's Degree, (Weighting 3/6);

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The final (average) grade of the academic degree of application is considered as mentioned in the Certificate, on a scale of 0 to 20

3. Professional CV (Weighting 1/6).

Based on the applicant's CV, the following scores are assigned:

3.1. Working in Education: 10 points

3.2. Working with pay in another area related to Sports: 12 points

3.3. No professional activity or other professions not linked to Sports: 14 points

6. Required documentation:

- Certificate of Bachelor Degree with final grade average (diploma). (academic transcript) (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra);
- Curricular structure with ECTS distributed by scientific areas of the course that the candidate holds. COMPULSORY document, with the exception of the cases of courses taught on FCDEFUC.;
- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Identification document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008);
- Official document, issued by the Institution awarding the degree, indicating the weighted average (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants that present a diploma that does not specify weighted average).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.

7. Tuition fee:

- Portuguese students or equivalent: 697 EUR (annual fee);
- International student: 7,000 EUR (annual fee).

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8. Part-time registration: Allowed.

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a 50EUR fee, which is non-refundable, even in case of invalidation of application and of non-placement.
- Registration and enrollment of International Students is only confirmed after a single payment corresponding to 30% of the total tuition fee (payment of 3 months of tuition), plus the application fee.
- Applications are submitted online at: <https://inforestudante.uc.pt/nonio/security/candidaturas.do>.
- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply **conditionally**. If they do not submit the required documents until the new deadline provided, they can move their application into the following call without any additional charges. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become “Not Admitted” in the final ranking list.
- In applications definitively considered valid, and after the evaluation period has started, it is not possible to add or replace the documents presented. To add new documentation, a new application must be submitted in the next phase, if any.
- After the last phase of applications, and if there are still places available, applicants may submit their application by means of a request, beyond the deadline, which will be duly appraised by the coordination of the Course /Organisational Unit.
