Postgraduate studies in Economics and Management in Health Organizations

1. Number of places:

17 Total places

- 1st call: 0 places

- 2nd call: 5 places

- 3rd call: 12 places

- Of the global vacancies, 2 vacancies are for recent graduates from FEUC (degree obtained in the last two academic years).

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 8

3. Application deadlines:

- 2nd call: 1st June to 16th July 2021

- 3rd call: 1st to 10th September 2021

4. Admission requirements:

Applicants for admission to the Postgraduate studies in Economics and Management in Health Organizations must be:

a) Holders of a Bachelor's degree, or legal equivalent, namely holders of degrees taught at FEUC or equivalent, as well as holders of degrees in Medicine, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Nursing, Health Technologies or other appropriate degrees;

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- b) Holders of a foreign higher academic degree awarded following a 1st cycle of studies organized according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a State compliant with this Process;
- c) Holders of foreign higher education degree that is recognized as meeting the objectives of a bachelor's degree by the Scientific Committee of the Faculty of Economics;
- d) In duly justified cases, holders of a scientific and professional curriculum relevant for completing this cycle of studies as recognized the competent Scientific Committee.

5. Selection criteria:

- 1. Academic, professional and research curriculum (Weighting 10/10):

- 1.1 Academic curriculum (60%)

Academic evolution of the candidates (2nd and 3rd cycles) and scientific area in which they obtained the degrees.

- 1.2. Professional and research curriculum (40%)

Existence of publications or participation in research projects and management and / or management functions that they may perform in their professional activity. The situation of recent graduates is taken into account.

Note: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- Certificate of higher education degree held, indicating the final classification, or certificate of academic qualifications, for the cases provided for in the admission requirements. (MANDATORY except for UC students and alumni).;
- Certificate of other post-graduate courses completed, if any, including workload and programmes;
- Copy of identification document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- Curriculum vitae, available at <https://www.uc.pt/feuc/eea/diplomas/egos/Candidaturas/Documentos>; (MANDATORY);
- Document mentioning the specific curricular units for which equivalence is requested and the previous 2nd cycle course (or pre-Bologna bachelor's degree) completed, which may justify such equivalence (REQUIRED if you wish to request credit equivalence);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request; (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna

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Process – after 2007/2008).

Note: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file. 1,650 € (annual fee).

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a 50EUR fee, which is non-refundable, even in case of invalidation of application and of non-placement.
- Applications are submitted online at: <https://inforestudante.uc.pt/nonio/security/candidaturas.do>.
- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply conditionally. If they do not submit the required documents until the new deadline provided, they can move their application into the following call without any additional charges. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become “Not Admitted” in the final ranking list.
- In applications definitively considered valid, and after the evaluation period has started, it is not possible to add or replace the documents presented. To add new documentation, a new application must be submitted in the next phase, if any.
- After the last phase of applications, and if there are still places available, applicants may submit their application by means of a request, beyond the deadline, which will be duly appraised by the coordination of the Course /Organisational Unit.
