1st cycle Bachelor's Degree in Modern Languages

1. Number of places:

1st Call:

1st year: 3 places

Remaining years: 0 places

NOTE: The approval of the number of places depends on the guiding order regarding the establishment of places, for the academic year 2021/2022, which will be published by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Higher Education (MCTES) and which may, consequently, imply changes.

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 1st July to 13th August 2021

4. Admission requirements:

This regime accepts applicants that:

- 1. Hold a bachelor's, master's or doctor's degree;
- 2. Hold the extinct courses of the Primary Magisterium, of Childhood Educators and of General Nursing and also a secondary education course, a complementary course to the secondary education or the 10th / 11th grade of secondary school;
- 3. Are not covered by the international student's statute regulated by Decree-Law no. 36/2014, of March 10, amended and republished by Decree-Law no. 62/2018, of August 6.

NOTE: Applicants of Portuguese nationality or equivalent, with a higher academic degree obtained abroad, can apply as long as they hold a degree equivalence or recognition of qualifications.

5. Selection criteria:

- Final classification, after application of the selection criteria (Weighting 10/10):
- a) Classification of the higher degree course, the course of the primary teaching profession, the course of the kindergarten teacher or the general nursing course, in descending order;
- b) Degree and diploma, priority being given successively to holders of a secondary course, of a higher education course without degree, of the previous course of bachelor (before the Bologna Process) and of the present course of bachelor.

If the classification referred to in point a) is included in the certificate with a decimal part, the certificate must be rounded off to the units, being a unit a fraction no lower than 5 decimals.

6. Required documentation:

- 1- Certificate from higher education course completed with average classification obtained; (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
- 2- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- 3- Identification document;
- 4- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- 5- Transcript detailing subjects studied (ECTS or hours) and grade per subject (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
- 6- Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, unless the course of origin is taught at the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process after 2007/2008)).

NOTE: The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.
