To hold a Portuguese secondary education diploma or equivalent or a foreign education diploma that provides access to higher education in the country of origin.

6. Required documentation:

Applications to the Special Call for Access and Admission of International Students are submitted online at: https://inforestudante.uc.pt/nonio/security/candidaturas.do, following the steps provided at http://www.uc.pt/international-applicants/oportunidades/1ciclo/candidatura. The documents referred to on the above-mentioned page must be uploaded through the on-line applications system during the application process.

NOTE: Admitted applicants who register and enroll in the course are required to present the original documents until the 31st of December in order to complete their individual student file. The documents mentioned above must be certified by the local Portuguese consulate and / or legalized by the Apostille system under the Convention on Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (better known as the Hague Convention), signed at The Hague, October 5, 1961, with the exception of documents issued by European Union Member-States. However, in case of doubt about the documentation presented, the aforementioned certification or submission of additional documentation may be requested to any applicant. If the above-mentioned documents are in a foreign language other than Spanish, French or English, a translation must be presented. Translations must be duly certified by the competent authorities.

7. Tuition fee:

7,000 euros/year.
