2nd cycle

Master in teaching of Physics and Chemistry to the 3rd cycle of basic education and the secondary education level

1. Number of places:

2nd call: 19 places

3rd call: 1 place + remaining places

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable.

3. Application deadlines:

2nd call: 1st June to 15th July 2022

3rd call: 1st to 13th September 2022

4. Admission requirements:

1. In accordance with D.L. 79/2014, applicants must meet all of the following conditions:

a) Hold a bachelor's degree or one of the qualifications referred to in points a) to c) of no. 1 of art. 17 of D.L. 65/2018;

b) Have completed at least 120 credits (ECTS) in the two disciplinary areas (Physics and Chemistry) and in none of them less than 50 credits in bachelor's degree or in other higher education degrees;

c) Have obtained approval in a written and oral exam aimed at verifying the command of the Portuguese language and the capacity for logical and critical argumentation.

2. Besides meeting the requirements of 1a) and 1c) but not 1b), have obtained 75% of the required credits in teaching of these two subjects.

3. Besides meeting the requirements of 1b) and 1c) but not of 1a), hold a school, scientific or

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professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting to the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies as recognized by the Scientific Committee of FCTUC, having obtained a CV assessment of 9.5 out of 20 or higher.

NOTE: Access to Teaching Masters requires a Portuguese test.

3rd Phase of Applications

Written test - September 20, at 10:00 am (Mainland Portugal Time)

5. Selection criteria:

A. Quality of the academic and professional course, (4/6 Weighting);

B. Interest in the new course, (1/6 Weighting);

C. Duration of formation on University of Coimbra, (1/6 Weighting);

i) Academic curriculum, considering the final classification of the degree(s) held, (45/100 Weighting);

Regarding the access referred to in sub-paragraph d) of paragraph 1 of the conditions of admission: The CV of applicants is rated on a scale of 0 to 20 in criteria i) to iv) and according to their respective weights:

ii) Relevance of the degree(s) held for the scientific area of the study cycle, (45/100 Weighting);

iii) Scientific curriculum, considering participation in congresses, seminars, research projects, number and scientific quality of publications (monographs, book chapters, articles in periodicals), prizes and similar awards, provided these activities are in the scientific area of the study cycle in question, (5/100 Weighting);

iv) Professional curriculum, considering the duration and nature of the professional activities performed in the scientific area of the study cycle in question, (5/100 Weighting)

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- Certificate of degree with final classification obtained (diploma). If the certificate does not

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indicate the average of completion, a certificate proving approval in the curricular units carried out must be included, with respective classifications (school transcript) (MANDATORY, except if the origin course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);

- Curricular structure with ECTS distributed by scientific areas of the course that the candidate holds. COMPULSORY document, with the exception of the cases of courses taught on FCTUC.;
- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Identification document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008);
- Official document, issued by the Institution awarding the degree, indicating the weighted average (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants that present a diploma that does not specify weighted average).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done until the 31st of December of the year of entry in order to complete their personal file.

7. Tuition fee:

- National Student or equivalent: 697 EUR (fee subject to change after approval of the state budget).
- International student: 7,000 EUR (annual fee).

10. Other information:

- Application is subject to the payment of a 50.00 € fee, which is non-refundable, even in case of

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invalidation of application and of non-placement.

- Registration and enrollment of International Students is only confirmed after a single payment corresponding to 30% of the total tuition fee (payment of 3 months of tuition), plus the application fee.
- Applications are submitted online at: <https://inforestudante.uc.pt/nonio/security/candidaturas.do>.
- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply conditionally. If they do not submit the required documents until the new deadline provided, they can move their application into the following call without any additional charges. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become "Not Admitted" in the final ranking list.
- In applications definitively considered valid, and after the evaluation period has started, it is not possible to add or replace the documents presented. To add new documentation, a new application must be submitted in the next phase, if any.
- After the last phase of applications, and if there are still places available, applicants may submit their application by means of a request, beyond the deadline, which will be duly appraised by the coordination of the Course /Organisational Unit.
