1. Number of places:

- 1st call: 30 places
- 2nd call: 30 places

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 5

3. Application deadlines:

- 1st call: 28th July to 11th September 2023
- 2nd call: 13th November 2023 to 4th February 2024

4. Admission requirements:

It is recommended that the students of the course have (or attend) a higher education course, or have relevant professional experience within the scope of this training.

Knowledge of mathematics, computer science and data processing is also recommended, as well as English language skills for consulting the recommended bibliography.

Conditions for attendance: the course requires the installation of the R software and its IDE, Rstudio, and the use of spreadsheets (e.g. Excel).

A curricular evaluation will be carried out for the purpose of evaluation and selection of candidates.

5. Selection criteria:

- Curriculum evaluation, (20/20 Weighting).

6. Required documentation:

- Declaration on honour of the veracity of documents and data submitted to the UC (document available in Inforestudante, in the application area).; (MANDATORY);
- Copy of Identity Document(MANDATORY only for international candidates);
- Curriculum vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Proof of English language level or Declaration of English language proficiency (document available in Inforestudante, in the application area).; (MANDATORY);
- Qualifications certificate that proves the fulfillment of the condition for admission to the course (COMPULSORY except for UC students and ex-students);.

NOTE: Students who enrol and register in the course must have the original certified qualification documents in their possession.

In the case of foreign students, the documents must be certified by the Portuguese embassy or consulate in the country of origin, or through the Apostille of the Hague Convention. If the documents are not in Portuguese, Spanish, French or English, they must be translated into Portuguese by a translator recognized by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

Documents must be scanned and submitted in the application in a legible form without erasures, accompanied by the declaration of authenticity duly filled in, signed and scanned, which is available in the online application form (InforEstudante).
