Note: A special quota of up to 30% of the places in the general contingent is reserved for applicants from schools in Brazil with which the University of Coimbra has a protocol or cooperation agreement and for applicants who have participated in activities or courses aimed at international students, namely, Universidade de Inverno, UC Diáspora and INSpire (see the list here: https://www.uc.pt/brasil/uc-visita-brasil/acordo_escolas). If the places reserved for this special quota are not taken, they will revert to the general quota.

2nd call: 18 March to 7 May 2024

3rd call: 15 May to 30 June 2024

Extra call: 8 July to 8 August 2024

4. Admission requirements:

To hold a Portuguese secondary education diploma or equivalent or a foreign education diploma that provides access to higher education in the country of origin.

6. Required documentation:

The application is submitted at Inforestudante in accordance with the instructions published annually on the UC website (<http://www.uc.pt/candidatos-internacionais/opportunidades/1ciclo>).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

- The Bachelor's Degree in Portuguese-Brazilian Law is intended for international students and does not guarantee, for the moment, the exercise of forensic professions.

- The course will only start if a minimum of 20 places are filled for the academic year.

- Application is subject to the payment of a fee in the amount of 50.00 €, non-refundable, including in cases of invalidation of application and non-placement.
