1. Number of places:

1st Call:

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable

3. Application deadlines:

1st call: 1st July to 16th August 2024

4. Admission requirements:

Applicants to the access and admission to the course may be:

- Individuals who hold a bachelor's, master's or doctor's degree;
- Individuals who hold the extinct courses of the Primary Magisterium, of Childhood Educators and of General Nursing and also a secondary education course, a complementary course to the secondary education or the 10th / 11th grade of secondary school;
- Individuals who are not covered by the status of International Student that is ruled by Decree-Law no. 36/2014 of 10th March, in its current wording;
- Individuals who meet the Prerequisite: Group B - Interpersonal communication.

Documentation required: Medical statement, according to Annex IV of Deliberation No.

316/2024 of 13th March, proving that the applicant meets the prerequisite required at the time of enrollment and registration, without which enrolment and registration is not possible.

NOTE: Applicants of Portuguese nationality or equivalent, with a higher academic degree obtained abroad, can apply as long as they hold a degree and diploma recognition.

5. Selection criteria:

Final classification will be obtained through the following formula - $(2A+2B+C)/5 \times D$ - with score rounded off to the tenths, in which: [10/10 Weighting]

A - Corresponds to the number of credits awarded using the European system of transfer and accumulation of credits (ECTS), being only accepted ECTS credits of the curricular units of the curriculum of the course which the applicant intends to attend and which are correspondent to the curricular units of origin that, after analysis by the Faculty, are recognized as equivalent;

B - Corresponds to the average classification of the curricular units of the course of origin that are recognized as equivalent, according to the previous paragraph;

C - Corresponds to the classification of the Higher Education degree held;

D - Corresponds to a factor that will be assigned the value of:

- a) 1.5 to undergraduate degrees obtained by attending the Master's Degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences in other University Higher Education Institutions, and other undergraduate degrees of the Faculty of Pharmacy of the University of Coimbra and the undergraduate degrees in Pharmacy in Polytechnic Higher Education;
- b) 1.0 to the other undergraduate degrees.

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- 1- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- 2- Certificate from higher education course completed with average classification obtained; (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
- 3- Transcript detailing subjects studied (ECTS or hours) and grade per subject (MANDATORY, except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra);
- 4- Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008).
- 5- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- 6- Identity Document (MANDATORY, only for foreign applicants);
- 7- A copy of the syllabus of the course of origin, and transition plan, if, however during the course of this course has been appropriate to Bologna; MANDATORY unless it is a course taught at the

University of Coimbra).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done as soon as possible in order to complete their personal file. Further information at: <https://www.uc.pt/en/academicos/inscricoes/PIAs>.

- Application is subject to the payment of a 50.00 € fee, which is non-refundable, even in case of invalidation of application and of non-placement.

- Applicants who do not have the documents attesting the required qualifications or other documents until the end of the deadline for applications may apply conditionally. If they do not submit the required documents until the new deadline provided, they can move their application into the following call without any additional charges. If they choose not to move their application within the mentioned deadline, their application will become "Not Admitted" in the final ranking list.

- In applications definitively considered valid, and after the evaluation period has started, it is not possible to add or replace the documents presented. To add new documentation, a new application must be submitted in the next phase, if any.
