**4. Admission requirements:**

1. Applicants to the cycle of studies leading to this Master's degree must be:

a) Holders of a bachelor's degree or legal equivalent namely degree holders in Management or related areas, such as Accounting and / or Finance;

b) Holders of a foreign higher academic degree awarded following a 1st cycle of studies organized according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a State compliant with this Process;

c) Holders of a higher academic degree obtained abroad that is recognized as meeting the objectives of the degree of bachelor in one of the areas mentioned under the previous points by the competent Scientific Committee;

d) Holders of an academic, scientific or professional CV recognized as adequate for pursuing this cycle of studies by the Scientific Committee of the Faculty of Economics of the University of

Coimbra according to the following criteria, in which applicants must obtain an evaluation of 14 points or higher.

2. The recognition referred to in sub-paragraphs b) to d) of paragraph 1 merely provides access to the study cycle leading to the degree of master and does not confer on its holder the equivalence to the degree of bachelor or the recognition of that degree.

### **5. Selection criteria:**

- 1.1 Academic curriculum: Undergraduate degree, [50/100 Weighting];
2. Professional Curriculum: Professional merit (includes internships, volunteering experience, associative manager experience, training courses, conferences and seminars), [25/100 Weighting];
  - 2.1 Years of professional activity (10/100);
  - 2.2 Field of professional activity (including traineeships and volunteering) (15/100)
3. Motivation: Motivation letter, [25/100 Weighting].
  - 3.1 Reasons for application (20/100);
  - 3.2 Writing quality (5/100)

Regarding the access referred to in sub-paragraph d) of paragraph 1 of the conditions of admission: The CV of applicants is rated on a scale of 0 to 20 in criteria i) to iii) and according to their respective weights:

- i) Ai) Academic curriculum, considering Relevance of the degree(s) held for the scientific area of the study cycle, [25/100 Weighting];
- ii) Professional curriculum, considering the duration and nature of the professional functions performed in the scientific area of the study cycle under consideration, including internships, volunteering experience and participation in conferences and seminars, [50/100 Weighting];
- iii) Motivation for the application, explaining the personal and professional interest in the scientific area of the study cycle under consideration, as well as the interest in the institution of application, [25/100 Weighting].

**NOTE:** Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

### **6. Required documentation:**

- Certificate from other post-graduate courses completed, if any, including time and program;
- Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma). A certificate proving approval in the curricular units carried out must be included, with respective classifications (school transcript). (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);

- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Identification document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008);
- Official document certifying qualifications, issued by the institution awarding the degree, indicating the weighted average and the grading scale. (MANDATORY only for holders of a degree obtained abroad that does not contain the average).

**NOTE:** If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done as soon as possible in order to complete their personal file. Further information at: <https://www.uc.pt/en/academicos/inscricoes/PIAs>.
