2. Minimum number of students for course opening: 6**3. Application deadlines:**

4. Admission requirements:

1. Eligible candidates to this course include:

a) holders of a BA in Languages and Literatures, with a component in Portuguese, or a legally equivalent degree and holders of a BA in other fields or a legally equivalent degree;

b) Holders of a foreign BA degree in the scientific areas mentioned under a) structured in accordance with the principles of the Bologna Process by a signatory state;

c) Holders of a foreign higher education degree, in the areas referred to in paragraph a) recognized to meet the objectives of a BA degree;

d) Holders of an academic, scientific or professional CV recognized as adequate for pursuing this cycle of studies by the Scientific Committee of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities of the University of Coimbra, in which applicants must obtain an evaluation of 9.5 points or higher.

ADMINISTRATION

2. The recognition referred to in sub-paragraphs b) to d) of paragraph 1 only provides access to the study cycle leading to the degree of master and does not confer the equivalence to the degree of bachelor or the recognition of that degree.

3 - Applicants whose mother tongue is not Portuguese require, as a minimum level of linguistic proficiency in Portuguese, level C1, as defined in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The level of proficiency will be assessed by individual interview. This interview is eliminatory.

The interviews will be held via videoconference, on April 13th (1st phase), July 28th (2nd phase), and September 21st (3rd phase), according to a schedule to be sent to candidates by email.

5. Selection criteria:**2nd Cycle Course**

- a) Classification of Bachelor's degree or equivalent, [4/10 Weighting];
- b) Curriculum vitae, [4/10 Weighting];
- c) Motivation candidate, [2/10 Weighting].

2nd Cycle - Application based on Subparagraph d)

- i) Academic curriculum, considering the final classification of the degree(s) held, [25/100 Weighting];
- ii) Relevance of the degree(s) held for the scientific area of the study cycle, [25/100 Weighting];
- iii) Scientific curriculum, considering participation in congresses, seminars, research projects, number and scientific quality of publications (monographs, book chapters, articles in periodicals), prizes and similar awards, provided these activities are in the scientific area of the study cycle in question, [25/100 Weighting];
- iv) Professional curriculum, considering the duration and nature of the professional activities performed in the scientific area of the study cycle in question, [25/100 Weighting].

NOTE: Assessed applications that have a grade lower than 9.5 in one of the evaluation criteria will automatically become non-approved.

6. Required documentation:

- Certificate of Bachelor's degree with final course classification (diploma). A certificate proving approval in the curricular units carried out must be included, with respective classifications (school transcript). (MANDATORY, except if the primary course is a course taught at the University of Coimbra);

- Curriculum Vitae; (MANDATORY);
- Identification document (MANDATORY only for foreign applicants);
- Motivation Letter; (MANDATORY);
- Official declaration of course outlines and hourly course loads with classification of each course unit of courses previously taken (transcript), in case of equivalence credits request (MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008);
- Official document certifying qualifications, issued by the institution awarding the degree, indicating the weighted average and the grading scale. (MANDATORY only for holders of a degree obtained abroad that does not contain the average).

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done as soon as possible in order to complete their personal file. Further information at: <https://www.uc.pt/en/academic-services/submit-docs/>.
