1st call: 5 places

Note: The ranking list is organized into two groups: 1st curricular year and other years.

The placement of each applicant in one of these groups depends on the number of credited ECTS:

Up to 35 credited ECTS → the applicant is considered for the 1st curricular year.

36 or more credited ECTS → the applicant is placed in the other years group.

The vacancies indicated are intended exclusively for the 1st curricular year.

For the other years contingent, vacancies may be released up to the limit of the places offered in the call, and only when there are applicants who meet the conditions to be included in this contingent.

The allocation of these vacancies is always carried out according to the applicants' ranking order.

2. Minimum number of students for course opening: Not applicable**3. Application deadlines:**

1st call: 1st to 8th July 2026

4. Admission requirements:

Applicants to the access and admission to the course must be:

- Individuals who do not hold academic qualifications to apply to higher education;
- Individuals who have successfully accomplished the over 23 years old Specially Adequate Exam

intended to assess their Ability to attend Higher Education that is valid for the course to which they want to apply;

- Individuals who are not covered by the status of International Student that is ruled by Decree-Law no. 36/2014 of 10th March, in its current wording.

5. Selection criteria:

- Classification of the specially adapted exam to assess the capacity to attend higher education for students over 23, [10/10 Weighting].

6. Required documentation:

1 - Motivation Letter [MANDATORY];

2 - Identification document [MANDATORY, only for foreign applicants];

3 - Transcript detailing subjects studied (ECTS or hours) and grade per subject [MANDATORY, if credits are to be requested except in degrees obtained at the University of Coimbra];

4 - Workload and programmes of curricular units if credits are to be requested [MANDATORY, except in degrees awarded by the University of Coimbra under the Bologna Process – after 2007/2008].

NOTE: If the documents mentioned above are written in a foreign language other than Spanish, French, and English, it is mandatory to present a translation to Portuguese undertaken by a translator recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic representation.

The submission of the authenticated original documents is mandatory to the applicants admitted who enrol and register and must be done as soon as possible in order to complete their personal file. Further information at: <https://www.uc.pt/en/academic-services/submit-docs/>.

7. Tuition fee:
